

VIDEO PROGRAM NETWORK CLOSED CAPTIONING QUALITY CERTIFICATION

Federal Communications Commission (FCC) rules implementing new closed captioning quality standards take effect on March 16, 2015. This is to certify that, as of March 16, 2015, EURONEWS is in compliance with the applicable FCC requirements concerning the quality of closed captioning, as indicated below:

- Is exempt from the closed captioning rules.



In response regarding closed captioning compliance, the programming services supplied by Euronews are exempt from the closed captioning requirements based upon 47 CFR Part 79.1 (d) 11 which provides, in relevant part, that no video programming provider shall be required to expend any money to caption any video programming if such expenditure would exceed 2% of the gross revenues received from that channel during the previous calendar year.
